This 1-day assessed course is for health professionals who may encounter resuscitation events in their occupation or workplace.

What you'll gain

This course focuses on the practical skills of resuscitation, and scenarios for the management of collapse and medical emergencies and will give you:

- › The confidence and skills to use advanced resuscitation equipment and techniques available within your workplace.
- › An Intermediate Resuscitation Skills certificate, and 8 CPD credits.
- › The confidence in establishing team behaviour, and the importance of roles during a cardiac arrest in line with the principles of high-performance CPR.

Course content

Recognise and provide advanced resuscitation including:

- › Manage an adult, child, and infant resuscitation.
- › Manage an airway with head tilt, chin lift and jaw thrust.
- › Insert airway adjuncts including: OPA, LMA, i-Gel, Bag mask ventilation.
- › Suction an airway.
- › Safely administer oxygen from a cylinder.
- › Manage anaphylaxis with IM adrenaline.
- › Safe use of a defibrillator.

- › Holds a formal tertiary qualification in a health-related discipline and are new to their area of practice.
- › Attendees are health professionals who need resuscitation skills as part of their scope of practice.
