In June 2024, Kōwhai Valley Crèche Trust was established by the families of Glenorchy Playgroup, who are working together to open a community-based early childhood education and care centre at the Playgroup premises. The Trust aims to support 2-5 aged children in Tāhuna Glenorchy and surrounding areas, working cooperatively with Playgroup to assist with the development of our children.

While this will not be able to fulfil the needs of all families in Glenorchy, it will help to alleviate the desperate need for ECE in the region. It's envisioned that the playgroup and the creche will be able to expand into their new premises once it is built.
